This week...

Reader's workshop: This week in Reader's workshop we focused on our characters and how they change in our books. We described how our characters are feeling in our books and why they are feeling they way they are. We also examined the lessons of books and talked about why authors write books. There can be multiple different lessons within one book!

writer's workshop: This week in writer's workshop we created realistic fiction characters and came up with different "troubles" our characters are going to get into. Based on our own experiences, we can set up small moment stories for our characters. Students are having a great time thinking about the dilemmas their characters are going to get into.

Math: This week in math we wrapped up unit 4.
Students took a post test and demonstrated their understanding of measurement. Unit 5 focuses on numbers to 1,000!

Science: This week we started a new unit! Students will spend the next month learning about solids, liquids, and gases. We learned about the different characteristics of the states of matter. Students completed a sorting activity where they placed different objects into the specified categories.
