Teacher's Note:

Every day students will keep track of their classroom behavior on their personal behavior sheet that corresponds with our classroom behavior chart. When students move their clips up and down, they will reflect as to why they moved their clip. Ask your child where he/she landed at the end of the day. It can be a great conversation starter about the day!

This week...

Reader's workshop: This week in Reader's workshop we learned about how to make predictions based on what we know about our characters. For example, Junie B. Jones is a crazy, enthusiastic kindergartner. Therefore, we can predict she will act in a dramatic way when she encounters any situation. We can make accurate predictions based on what we know about our characters.

<u>writer's workshop</u>: In writer's workshop we learned how to add non-fiction text features to our non-fiction books. We can add bold print, captions, headings, pronunciation guides, etc to make our books more exciting and informative.

Math: This week in math we learned more about measurement. We understand the difference between inches, feet, and yards. We found out that when we measure a distance in inches, the number is larger. When we measure that same distance with feet, the number is smaller. We also worked on addition and subtraction on a number line as well. Students enjoyed comparing and contrasting each other's work.

Science: we began our new unit on nutrition. we learned about the different food groups and what it means to have a balanced diet. Students chose a food group to research. we will turn our findings into a google presentation!
