This week...

Reader's workshop: This week in readers' workshop, we have been focusing on nonfiction books again. We are working on using the text features, and recognizing and anticipating "lingo" words in our text. We have also worked on slowing our reading down so that we can really comprehend what we are reading.

writer's workshop: we began writing nonfiction "books" this week. The students are writing about topics for which they are "experts". All books are being added to the classroom library to other students can learn from their writing. We have many books about animals and sports, as well as many other topics. We have many great authors in our class.

Math: This week in math we have spent a lot of time working on number lines. We are learning to use number lines as a tool to help us add and subtract numbers. We also began looking at two digit numbers broken down into the tens and ones and adding them that way. We added some new workplaces to our repertoire to help us think like mathematicians.

Social Studies:

we will be starting a new social studies unit next week, but for this week we focused on team building, encouraging, and kindness. We talked about making sure our words are kind.
