This week...

Reader's workshop: This week in Reader's workshop we worked on fluency. We read with smooth voices and remembered to pause at punctuation marks. The students learned the importance of dialogue tags. Dialogue tags help us know how to talk as characters from our fiction books. Students also learned the value of punctuation. Strong readers notice and pay attention to punctuation marks because it helps understand our reading better.

writer's workshop: This week in writer's workshop we added juicy details to our realistic fiction stories. We also learned how to make series books. Because we spent so much time creating our powerful characters, we know we can make series books using the characters over and over again.

Math: This week in math we wrapped up our counting to 1000 activities. Students took a mid-unit quiz to show their understanding of numbers within 1,000. We started learning more about money. We know the value of different coins and can make amounts using different coins. Students raced to see who could come up with the most combinations to 25 cents within a minute. We also learned about who is on each coin.
