Teacher's Note:

We presented an assembly today on Kindness. Second grade students shared how one act of kindness can affect an entire group of people. We also showed the school a new kindness program where we can start our day off right by reading a kind message or creating a kind message to spread kindness.

This week...

Reader's workshop: This week in Reader's workshop we worked on making inferences. While we read we can make assumptions or inferences based on what the author is writing. Even though the author does not flat out say things, we can make assumptions based on the clues around us.

writer's workshop: This week in writer's workshop we focused on poetry. Students learned about different types of poems including cinquain and diamante poems.

Math: This week in math we learned about area. Students designed shapes with a certain amount of square units. They also worked on two-step word problems with two equations and two number lines.

Science: We continued our chat on the layers of the atmosphere. Students thought it was interesting to see what happens in every layer. We learned that we live in the troposphere!
